 - Performance Indicator (results baseline)


Program (Grouping of projects)

For instance, one goal is to build 40 schools in Muscat. This goal has its own workflow (Programe > Project > Workspaces > Streams > tasks)


Add Organizations Vision & Mission

First of all, the user can add vision and mission by clicking the "Add Vision Statement" and "Add Mission Statement" button.




Add Priority

The users can add priorities under the vision and mission statement.




Add Goals and Performance Indicators

The users can add goals and performance indicators under priority.




Add Programs

Users can add multiple programs under Prime.




Create projects under a program

Users can create multiple projects directly under a program.




Link projects under a program

Users can also link pre-existing projects to a program.




Add Projects

Users can create multiple projects in the "Project" module of Prime.




Link the project to a program





Create a project
